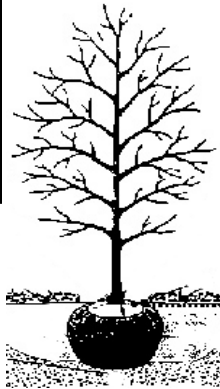

Vernon Triangle CID, and NOMA BID) to encourage new development. It was approved. ANC 6C approved this project which will fill a vacant lot previously owned by Third Street Church of God. The design is similar to 1215 4th with a flat brick façade & 2 over 2 windows. Neighbors advocated raising the height of the building to align with 1215 4th and adding cornice detailing according to the HPRB staff report and the owner's original plan. This project will be 2 units (2 level 2br/dens) with no basement. The developer is also restoring 1211 and 1209 which are coming along nicely. This project will be presented at the March MVSNA meeting.

(Brendan Meyer) This project will be presented at the March MVSNA meeting.**Single Sales Exemptions**This issue has been a source of intense debate in recent months as the ban on selling single containers of alcohol went into effect in Ward 6 and part of Ward 2. Following MVSNA's December vote to support an exemption request by Good Libations at 5th & M Streets NW, ANC 2C voted to support the exemption and ANC 6C voted to protest. On March 11th, ABRA granted the exemption to Good Libations. The next establishment in our area which is seeking an exemption is B & M Food Mart on the 200 Block of M Street NW. MVSNA recently entered into an updated voluntary agreement with B & M and will vote on the exemption request at our March meeting. ANC 6C will hear the matter twice: on April 1st at their Liquor Licensing Committee meeting and on April 8th at the full ANC 6C Commission meeting. Meeting locations are listed on the front page. Newly elected ANC2C04 Commissioner Theresa Sule surprised the public by nominating and voting for ANC2C03 Commissioner Doris Brooks as chair while ANC2C02 Commissioner Kevin Chapple nominated ANC2C01 Commissioner Alex Padro.
